The evaluation of the applicants' curriculum is equal to the sum of the scores obtained applying the following criteria:

- a) Exams grade average (page 1; table 1a)
- b) further bonuses (pages 1 & 2; tables 1b & 2b)

- EU students: students (applying in the I set of applications) who have completed 135 ECTS of the exams towards their Bachelor degree and who have – at the time of application – these exams already registered in the transcript; 145 ECTS already taken and registered for students applying in the II set of applications	4
- NON-EU students: students who have completed 80% of the exams towards their Bachelor degree (or equivalent title) and who have – at the time of application – these exams already registered in the transcript
