EVALUTATION CRITERIA

The evaluation of the applicants' curriculum is equal to the sum of the scores obtained applying the following criteria:

- a) **Exams grade average** (page 1; table 1a)
- b) **further bonuses** (pages 1 & 2; tables 1b & 2b)

<p>REGULAR ACADEMIC CAREER:</p> <p>- EU students: students (applying in the I set of applications) who have completed 135 ECTS of the exams towards their Bachelor degree and who have – at the time of application – these exams already registered in the transcript; 145 ECTS already taken and registered for students applying in the II set of applications</p> <p>- NON-EU students: students who have completed 80% of the exams towards their Bachelor degree (or equivalent title) and who have – at the time of application – these exams already registered in the transcript</p>	4



<p>Or</p> <p>- Students who completed their Bachelor degree (or equivalent title) no more than 2 years before application time</p>	
<p>KNOWLEDGE OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE: Students who have, at the time of application, a valid certification of English language (see MIBE official call webpage for the list of accepted certifications) confirming a minimum B2 level of English language knowledge.</p> <p>Please note: <u>the certification cannot be used as a bonus if necessary to satisfy the minimal entry requirements (lack of 5 ECTS in English language in the Bachelor degree)</u></p>	2
<p>BACHELOR DEGREE ENTIRELY TAUGHT IN ENGLISH</p> <p>Please note: <u>the bonus is not given if the student's country of origin is an English-speaking country (a country where English is the official language or one of the official languages)</u></p>	1
<p>INTERNATIONAL STUDIES EXPERIENCE</p> <p>Students who have at least 24 ECTS registered in their transcript (i.e.15% of the exams counting towards the Bachelor degree or equivalent title) at a university located in a country different from the one where the student resides</p>	3
<p>GMAT certification, or GRE certification with score converted in GMAT (see this link for GRE>GMAT score conversion)</p>	See table 2b
