

International Business and Entrepreneurship Admission to post first year a.y. 2025/2026

During the application evaluation process for admission to the first year of the Master's Degree course in International Business and Entrepreneurship, the Admissions Committee may decide to validate previous exams of candidates, who holding additional second level university qualifications, and intend to seek admission to the second year.

This procedure is possible exclusively for EU students or non-EU students residing in Italy.

Available spots for admission to the second year

The number of spots available for admission to years different from the first is calculated annually based on spots made available following refusals, transfers.

How to submit the application

- Submit the application for admission to MIBE 2025/2026 as indicated in the relative competition announcement.
- > In the online guided procedure, in addition to the course access requirements, also insert the exams for which you are requesting recognition.
- > The course of study, during the application evaluation process for the admission, evaluates also the declared exams by determining possible exam recognitions and any eventual admission to the second year of the course.
- > The offices responsible send to the various candidates their evaluation results.

Warning: in the case of exams already validated by previous careers, it is necessary to indicate the exam of the original career (the first time in which the exam was taken).

In case the number of applications exceeds the number of spots available:

The spots in the second year of the course will be assigned following the chronological order of applications submitted by the eligible candidates.

We remind all candidates that, remaining assigned to the first year, it is still possible to apply for "exam recognition" through the FILO DIRETTO for the exams obtained in previous careers.

Information notice pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of personal data

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter GDPR), the data provided by applicants will be processed by the University of Pavia, in its capacity as Data Controller, in order to pursue its institutional ends and carry out the University's public interest tasks, pursuant to art. 6 letter e) of the GDPR. In particular, the data will be processed to allow the provision of the specific services requested by users and relating to the completion of selection procedures for admission to study courses, as described in the competitive test notice, and the fulfilment of legal requirements. Data are collected in compliance with the principles of lawfulness, correctness, relevance, completeness and nonexcess, in relation to the purposes for which they are processed. Data processing is based on respect for the general principles of lawfulness, correctness, transparency, adequacy, relevance, and necessity, using appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect the privacy and the rights of data subjects. Processing is carried out, as a general rule, through the aid of computer-based and online tools to store and manage the collected data in some phases paper-based media may be used in all cases in such a way as to quarantee data

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Failure to consent to the provision of personal data will result in the applicant being excluded from the admission.

Failure to consent to the provision of personal data will result in the applicant being excluded from the admission test/excluded from the selection procedure.

Users' personal data may become known and processed, in compliance with current legislation on the subject, by personnel expressly in charge of data processing.

The data provided by applicants will be kept by the University of Pavia only for the time strictly necessary to pursue the above ends and, in any case, in compliance with legislation on the conservation of administrative documentation. Applicants shall enjoy the rights set forth in articles 15-18 of the aforementioned Regulation, including: access to personal data, their rectification, updating, integration, deletion, etc. as well as objection to the use of data other than the institutional ends mentioned above. Complaints should be submitted to the Data Controller and/or Data Protection Officer (DPO).
