LOHOS 26 – LOcus HOSpitalitatis26  
academic year 2025/26**

In the framework of the Erasmus+ Programme – KA131 Learning Mobility of Individuals, and on the basis of the results and the funds awarded under the project Erasmus Erasmus **2025-1-I102-KA-131-HED-000306528**, a call for students' selection is published to assign contributions to take part into the BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME named **LOHOS 26 – LOcus HOSpitalitatis26** hereafter referred to as "BIP".

The project seeks to raise awareness and train students in good practices of sustainable design and architecture with a multidisciplinary and multicultural approach to the existing buildings. To this end, inter-university groups will be created around the challenge of the reuse of an existing building in Giessen. These inter-university and interdisciplinary teams will share the approach and the knowledges of the building technologies used in their countries to bring new life to a building not used but full of historic meaning. The results will be different projects developed respecting the cultural and social environment.

## **1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Applicants must fulfil the following compulsory criteria:

- To be duly enrolled at the **Master in Architecture Engineering** – (DICAr) University of Pavia for the entire duration of the mobility;
- To possess a proficiency in English language of at least a **level B1** of CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). Students will be required to communicate and discuss fluently in English, take part in group activities and in general to treat any topic with ease.
- To be able to face the design process focused on the reuse of an existing building in a sustainable and inclusive way.

## **2. DETAILS ABOUT THE MOBILITY**

The BIP **LOHOS 26 – LOcus HOSpitalitatis26** will take place **online on 20<sup>th</sup> July and on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2026** and in presence at the **Technische Hochschule Mittelhessen**, Giessen - Germany, **from 14<sup>th</sup> - 25<sup>th</sup> September** (both included). The course will be considered completed and funded only if the participants will attend the full programme of the entire online part and of the training days in presence.

**Technische Hochschule Mittelhessen** will provide the students with a certificate of attendance including the total number of hours attended together with the topics treated and the number of ECTS obtained (5).

### 3. MOBILITY GRANTS

The mobility grant includes:

- **individual support** of **79,00 €** per day per student (1.106,00€) for a maximum of 14 days; 12 (twelve) full days of training + 2 (two) days of travelling, immediately before and after the beginning and finishing date of the course.
- a **travel support** as follows:

The kilometres are calculated using the [Erasmus Distance Calculator](#).

3.1 The exact amount of the Erasmus Grant will be explained to the selected students in the Grant Agreements they will be required to sign.

3.2 Mobility grants will be paid by the University of Pavia as follows:

- The **individual support** of **1.106,00€ before the beginning of the mobility in presence**
- the **travel support** of **309,00€ after the beginning of the mobility in presence**, provided that the participant has attended the Blended Intensive programme school for its entire duration and they are able to provide travel documents (e.g. boarding passes). **The grant must be refunded in case the student will not be able to join the mobility its entire duration (physical + virtual).**

3.3 The mobility grant is a fixed amount of money that cannot be incremented under any circumstances.

3.4 The University of Pavia will provide its outgoing students with insurance covering accidents, civil liability and other guarantees in accordance with its internal procedures.

### 4. ONLINE APPLICATION AND DEADLINE

The applicant is required to complete the online application form at the following link by the **13/03/2026** at 12:00 CET - noon.

## 5. EVALUATION AND SELECTION

The selection will be made by a joint Committee established within the Department of Civil Engineering and Architecture headed by the Professor in charge of the BIP for the University of Pavia (Prof. Alessandro Greco).

The following criteria will be taken into consideration:

- The motivation letter;
- Relevance with study program;
- Attendance to accessibility and inclusion projects in collaboration with ANIE AssoAscensori;
- The marks in the exams of *Architettura Tecnica 1* and *Disegno dell'Architettura*.

In case of equal evaluation between two candidates, the Evaluation Commission reserves the right to give priority to those applications which add to the diversity of the study programme in terms of gender balance, year of study, and variety of mobility experience.

The Committee reserves the right to check the validity of declarations and supporting documents. False statements may lead to exclusion from the selection process and the award of the scholarship.

Each applicant will be notified about selection results and the grant in due time, via the email address provided in the application.

**Selected applicants must then officially accept the awarded grant by answering via email.**

## 6. PERSONAL DATA TREATMENT

Personal data submitted by the applicants will be used solely for application and selection procedures and institutional aims, and will be treated in accordance with the European General Data Protection Regulation no. 2016/679 art. 13.
